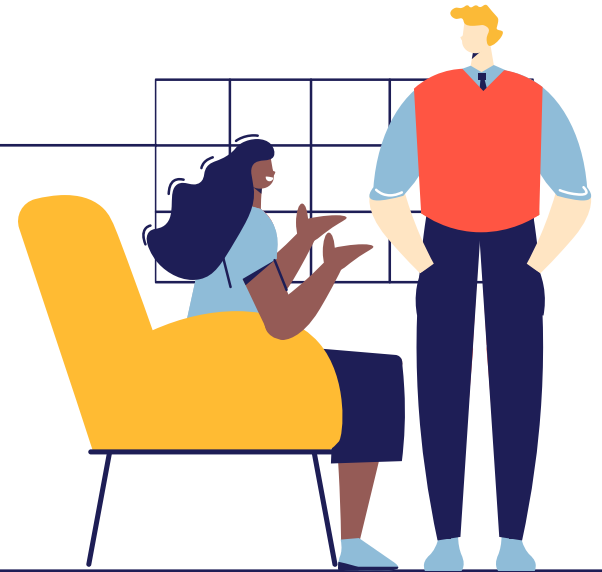
Community (France)

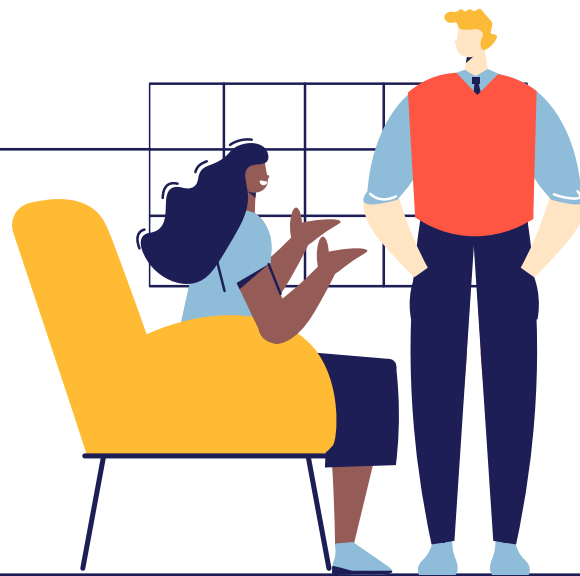


PP5 Active youth (Lithuania)

A for-purpose organization with an extensive experience in non-formal education. Most important topics: sustainability, social inclusion, healthy lifestyle, digital tools and human rights.

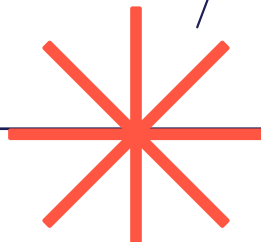
PP6 ADICE (France)

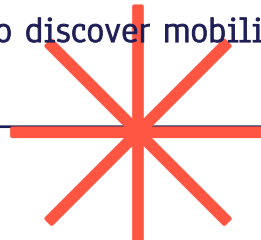


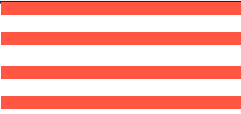
Youth exchanges

An opportunity for groups of young people from different countries, to meet, live together and work on shared projects for a short period. They are managed by youth organizations.

- **Duration:** 5 to 21 days (travel days are excluded)
- **Conditions:** Young people aged between 13 and 30 years old
- **Where?** European Union and partner countries
- **Financial support:** Costs related to travel, accommodation, project management and activities are covered by the programme according to a fixed price scale (see Erasmus+ programme)

=> A good opportunity for vulnerable YP to discover mobility (short period, collective project and animators to facilitate)

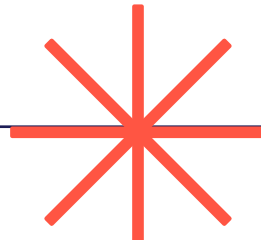




Discover EU

This programme enables young people from the EU and partner countries to discover one or more European countries. Young people have to apply themselves (call for applications twice a year). This project can be individual or collective (4 participants maximum).

- **Duration:** 1 day to 1 month (7 travel days maximum)
 - **Conditions:** Young people aged of 18 years old only
 - **Where?** European Union
 - **Financial support:** Train costs + Discount card for cultural visits valid throughout the EU
- => Accompanying person over 18 years old must pay for their own booking (travel and accomodation)



European Solidarity Corps

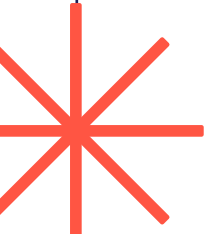
Explore : Living in a new country, meeting its people and discovering a new culture. An opportunity to realise a qualifying voluntary and solidarity mission (Youthpass certificate at the end of the project).

- **Duration:** 2 to 12 months
- **Conditions:** Young people aged between 18 and 30 years old
- **Where?** European Union and country partners
- **Financial support:** All costs are covered by the EU (travel costs, food, accommodation, pocket money, health insurance, language courses, mentoring)

=> Individual or collective opportunity. A good experience of living abroad without being left alone



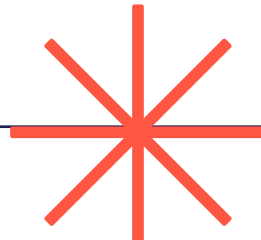
European Solidarity Corps



Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs

It aims to facilitate the crossborder exchange of experiences, to enable new European entrepreneurs to access specific knowledge related to business management and to build a network of business contacts by approaching an experienced European entrepreneur.

- **Duration:** 1 to 6 months
- **Conditions:** Entrepreneurs with a business less than 3 years old or future entrepreneurs with a viable business plan
- **Where?** EU
- **Financial support:** Accomodation and travel costs covered

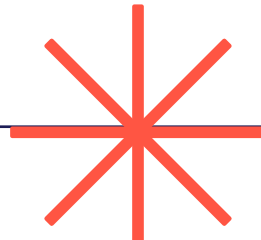


Youthpass

A European certificate that recognizes skills that were developed and acquired under Erasmus+ projects (Youth and ESC programs)

- For all Erasmus project (except DiscoverEU)
- Recognition of non-formal and informal learning outcomes
- Validated by the participant and the organization involved in the project
- EU + partner country

=> The Youthpass becomes mandatory for the organization when the participant asks for it
